Maintenance Tips Helpful tips from your Service Team





- Winter is officially here and with it brings freezing temperatures and snow or icy precipitation. Here are some helpful tips to help this winter:
- 1. When temperatures dip below freezing, let your faucets run on a steady drip to help prevent pipes from freezing. It is also a good idea to remove any hoses from outdoor faucets.
- 2. Keep cabinet doors slightly open under the sink to allow warm air to reach pipes.
- 3. Keep your heat at or above 55 degrees. Never turn your heat off, especially if you are leaving town.
- 4. Do not use any oil, gas or kerosene heaters. They are strictly prohibited.

- 5. In the event of power outages, please make sure you have plenty of batteries, flashlights and water. To report a power outage, please call Duke Energy at I-800-POWERON.
- 6. Keep your car ready for winter. Make sure your battery is working, wiper blades are good, and it's always a good idea to keep your gas tank between full and 1/2 a tank.
- In the event of snow and ice: Marsh Properties will NOT be responsible for the removal of snow and ice from the walkways and parking areas. We will do what we can to help the situation; however, in many cases we will have to do like the City of Charlotte and wait for it to melt.

TRASH AND RECYCLING

Never leave your trash on your front porch, patio, or balcony. All pet waste bags need to be properly disposed of in the pet waste receptacles found throughout the property or in the compactors. The recycling areas are meant for recycling only, household trash should be taken to the compactors.

Please remember to dispose of Christmas Trees at the recycling areas or next to the trash compactors. DO NOT put Christmas Trees into the trash compactor!

In an effort to protect and preserve the state's water resources and to prevent sanitary overflow, clogs and back-ups, Mecklenburg County has implemented several programs to include the **Grease Control Program**. In order to be in compliance with the programs rules and regulations, we must be diligent in the proper disposal of cooking grease.

Never pour grease down the drain, cool grease before discarding, mix grease with an absorbent material and dispose of it in a sealable container.




