Maintenance Corner Helpful tips from your Service Team

- **Countertops:** As a reminder, hot pots and pans should never be placed directly on the surface of the countertop. Always use a hot pad or trivet under pots, pans or baking dishes to prevent damage to the countertop.
- Winter Preparations: Remember to call and have your filter changed on a regular basis (30-45 days). Colder temperatures are on the way! As you begin to turn on your heaters, remember that dust may have settled in the coils and you may briefly have a burning smell. If you have gas heat, you may hear a clicking sound as the heat starts to come on. Once temperatures drop to freezing, make sure to keep your heat at or above 55 degrees. This will help prevent pipes from freezing and bursting. Please call the office if you have any concerns or questions about your heater.
- Plumbing: If the toilet overflows, remove the tank lid and push the flapper down. Also shut water off using the valve located behind the toilet.

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- Refrigerator tip: Keep your fridge clean and organized. Keeping food away from the back of the fridge will help air flow and keep items from freezing. Also keep a box of baking soda in the fridge and/or freezer to cut down on odors.

Time Warner Cable—Wiring Upgrades

Beginning in October, Time Warner Cable will be onsite to start updating the wiring throughout Strawberry Hill. This project is expected to continue until next Summer. Our neighborhood has been broken down into sections and will include both interior and exterior wiring. Since cable is included in the monthly rent, we will need to enter every apartment home, regardless of your chosen provider.

Weather permitting, the first section of buildings is scheduled to begin mid-October. You will receive notification from the Strawberry Hill Leasing Office within a few days of us needing to enter your apartment with a Time Warner Technician. A member of the Strawberry Hill Staff will accompany the technicians into your apartment home. If a resident cannot be home, we do ask that all pets are secured and alarms turned off on the dates we need to enter.

CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG STORM WATER SERVICES

In an effort to protect and preserve the state's water resources and to prevent sanitary overflow, clogs and back-ups, Mecklenburg County has implemented several programs to include the **Grease Control Program**. In order to be in compliance with the programs rules and regulations, we must be diligent in the proper disposal of cooking grease. Never pour grease down the drain, cool grease before discarding, mix grease with an absorbent material and dispose of it in a sealable container. **Grease is Your Drain's Worst Enemy so Remember... Collect It, Absorb It, Seal it, Trash It!**



- ALWAYS keep your vehicles locked and NEVER leave anything in plain sight. If you have phones, GPS devices, packages, or any other valuables, please remove them from your vehicle. Do not keep presents in the trunk of your car.
- Keep your front and back porch lights on during evening hours.
- Lock your doors to your apartment immediately behind you.
- Arrange for packages to be delivered elsewhere if you are not planning to be home to accept them. Do not leave any packages at your front door.
- If you will be away for an extended period of time consider having someone stay in your apartment or come by and check it regularly. Please notify the office if you do this.
- If you notice anything or anyone suspicious, we ask that you report it immediately. Call 9-1-1 first and then notify the office or after hours emergency at 704-366-1944.

Trash and Recycling

Please remember to take your trash to the compactors. Never leave your trash outside your front porch or back patio. The three-sided brick enclosures are not to be used for household trash. These areas are for moving boxes only. There is a compactor conveniently located adjacent to the Marsh House as well as near the 5101 Clubhouse (middle pool). We also have 11 recycling areas throughout the community to make recycling easier for you.
