THE POOL WILL BE OPEN APRIL 1st!


- All persons using the pool do so at their own risk.

- The pool hours are 10am until 10pm.
- You must have your Amenity Pass with you at all times--if you do not have one please come to the office.
- SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA AT ANY TIME.
- Anyone under the age of 16 MUST be accompanied by an adult. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Residents are limited to 2 guests per household and must accompany their guests.
- Glass is not permitted in the pool area at any time.
- Pets are not permitted in the pool area at any time.
- Throwing of balls, Frisbees, etc. and the use of water guns is strictly prohibited.
- Bikes, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades, etc. are not permitted in the pool area.
- Alcoholic beverage containers must be covered.
- Only appropriate bathing clothes are permitted.
- Please keep conversations and music at a reasonable level.
- No diving, running, splashing, horseplay, etc.

REMINDERS

- →Be mindful that your floor could be someone else's ceiling and that noise does travel.

- Call the after hours answering service at (704) 844-9410 for maintenance emergencies. If we do not respond within 15 minutes, Please call again!
- Non-emergency requests may be left on voicemail, emailed to: service@providenceparkapts.com. or use the Welcome Home Resident Portal!
- Use the Recycling area closest to you to prevent overflow in any one area. Diapers are NOT recyclable.
- Check your water heater room periodically.
- Notify the office immediately of any leak and/or moisture issue.
- Place only small remnants of food down the garbage disposal.
- Call for service for a clogged sink/tub do not use DrainO or other draining agent.
- If your A/C runs constantly and blows warm air, please shut it off and call in a service request ASAP.
- Call the office to request to have your fireplace pilot light turned off for the summer.
- Phase I Residents Call the office to have your water heater turned back down.
- It is important that the new pine needles remain undisturbed to help ensure that they will last and look good for as long as possible. Therefore, people and pets should not walk through them.

Grease Is Your Drain's Worst Enemy So Please Remember...

DO

- Pour greasy or oily food waste into a container, NOT down the drain or garbage disposal.
- Allow animal fats to cool or freeze in the container before throwing them in the trash.
- Mix liquid vegetable fats with an absorbent material such as cat litter or coffee grounds in a sealable container before throwing into the trash.

DO NOT

- Pour oil or grease down drains, garbage disposals or toilets.
- Use hot water to rinse grease off cookware, utensils, dishes or surfaces.
- Put food scraps down drains.


