### Grease is the Leading Cause of Sewer Overflows according to the City of Charlotte



#### Proper methods of disposing of grease and oil in your home:

- Mix liquid vegetable fats with an absorbent material such as cat litter or coffee grounds in a sealable container before throwing in the trash.
- Freeze or cool animal fats before discarding in the trash.
- Pour greasy or oily food waste into can or jar with a lid before of disposing it in the trash.
- Do not put food scraps down the drain.

When disposing of Christmas trees, please put them beside the brick recycling center on Myers Hunter Lane.



### Andy's Corner--Time to Winterize!



- During the cold season and to protect water pipes, please do not set your thermostat to less than 55 degrees.
- As fall approaches and you turn on the heat for the first time, remember there will be a slight smell as dust is burned off the coils of the heating elements.
- This is a good time to submit a request for service to replace your air filter through Active Building or by contacting the leasing office.
- Please let us know if you need the pilot light of your fireplace turned on by submitting a request for service or contacting the leasing office.
