

DO

- Pour greasy or oily food waste into a container, NOT down the drain or garbage disposal.
- Allow animal fats to cool or freeze in the container before throwing them in the trash.
- Mix liquid vegetable fats with an absorbent material such as cat litter or coffee grounds in a sealable container before throwing into the trash.

DO NOT

- Pour oil or grease down drains, garbage disposals or toilets.
- Use hot water to rinse grease off cookware, utensils, dishes or surfaces.
- Put food scraps down drains.

Please remember to keep your tags and registration current. All vehicles should also be in working order. Commercial vehicles are not permitted on the property.


