Come join us as we celebrate spring!




East Side News and Happenings

Grease is the leading cause of sewer overflow and Service Calls.

DO: Use an old coffee can or jar as a grease container. Pour greasy or oily food waste into the container.

DO: Allow animal fats to cool or freeze in the container before

throwing them in the trash

DO: Mix liquid vegetable fats with an absorbent material such as cat litter or coffee grounds in a sealable container before throwing in the trash.

DO NOT: Pour oil and grease down drains or garbage disposals DO NOT: Use hot water to rinse grease off cookware, utensils, dishes or surfaces.


DO NOT: Put food scraps down the drains.
