Grease is the leading cause of sewer overflow and Service Calls.

DO: Use an old coffee can or jar as a grease container.

Pour greasy or oily food waste into the container.

DO: Allow animal fats to cool or freeze in the container before
throwing them in the trash

DO: Mix liquid vegetable fats with an absorbent material such as cat
litter or coffee grounds in a sealable container before throwing in the
trash.

DO NOT: Pour oil and grease down drains or garbage disposals

DO NOT: Use hot water to rinse grease off cookware, utensils, dishes
or surfaces.

DO NOT: Put food scraps down the drains.

With fall approaching and cooler

check your heat to make sure your
heating system is working properly.

with gas or electric heat which is
common due to the dust burning off
