Service Tips for Spring


- I. Run your a/c before you need it. Avoid turning the air conditioner off completely. Instead, increase the temperature when you are away from home. The unit may run for a few minutes at a time while you are away, but this is more energy efficient than turning it on and having it run for a couple of hours to cool your home at the end of the day.
- Be sure to run your dishwasher at least once a month, especially in the summer months to prevent odors from forming in the basin of the dishwasher.
- 3. If your garbage disposal has an odor, you can use lime, lemon or other citrus fruit to clean the blades and countereffectively turn the disposal in to a citrus fan.
- 4. Anything electrical or water related should be called into Maintenance. If however, you have a leaking toilet, sink, or related fixture, you can mitigate any damage or clean up by shutting the water off at the supply before a Maintenance Technician arrives.

 Every water fixture in your apartment should have a shut off valve to stop the flow of water. Simply turn the valve clockwise until it is tight.




