Maintenance Tips

What is the Best Way to Dispose of Cooking Oil and Grease?

Cooking oil and animal fat will clog your pipes. The grease on dishes placed in a dishwasher will clog up the dishwasher drain, too. Whatever you do, don't pour fats, oil, or grease down the drain.

The simple answer is to throw it in the trash. To do so, just follow these steps.

- Allow the oil to cool
- Pour it into a container and close
- Toss the container into the trash bin

Do not pour hot oil into your trash can. It could melt the plastic trash bag and cause a mess. Also, use a container you can seal so that it doesn't spill out and potentially leak. A couple of options include an empty jar or, for larger amounts, an empty laundry soap bottle. And be sure to wipe oil-coated pans with a paper towel before washing.

Air Conditioning Season:

It's hard to believe, but a/c season is already here. Remember to change the air filter every 30 to 45 days. Other ways to help keep your system running properly is to keep the temperature set to one setting. Turning it off or up while you are not home will only make it work harder when you return during the hottest part of the day.

If you notice your air conditioner is not working properly, call the office as soon as possible so we can have one of our technicians come by to fix it for you.

Strawberry Hill Pool Reminders:

- All pool areas will be open from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM. Swimming is strictly prohibited after sunset.
- Persons under sixteen years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Smoking is not permitted in any amenity area.
- Glass containers are not permitted in the pool areas.
- No visible display of alcoholic beverages. (Please cover cans with koozies or similar item.)
- Music brought by the resident should be played at a volume for their space only or use headphones.
- Guests must be accompanied by a resident.
- Pets are not allowed on the pool deck.
- All residents must have an amenity pass (wrist band) to use the pool.

Hot Weather Safety Tips for Pets

- Pets can get dehydrated quickly, so give them **plenty of fresh**, **clean water** when it's hot or humid outdoors. Make sure your pets have a shady place to get out of the sun, be careful not to over-exercise them, and keep them indoors when it's extremely hot.
- Know the symptoms of overheating in pets, which include excessive panting or difficulty breathing, increased heart and respiratory rate, drooling, mild weakness, stupor or even collapse. Symptoms can also include seizures, bloody diarrhea and vomit along with an elevated body temperature of over 104 degrees.
- Animals with **flat faces**, like Pugs and Persian cats, are more susceptible to heat stroke since they cannot pant as effectively. These pets, along with the elderly, the overweight, and those with heart or lung diseases, should be kept cool in air-conditioned rooms as much as possible.
- Never leave your animals alone in a parked vehicle--it lead to a fatal heat stroke. Take note: North Carolina law prohibits leaving an animal in a confined vehicle when dangerous conditions are present.
- **Open unscreened windows pose a real danger to pets**, who often fall out of them. Keep all unscreened windows or doors in your home closed, and make sure adjustable screens are tightly secured.
- Feel free to trim longer hair on your dog, but **never shave your dog**: The layers of dogs' coats protect them from overheating and sunburn.
